and chattels, to wit, one cord of wood, of one William Sampson
of the value of Five Dollars then and there in the last of the
said William Sampson being found from and out of the
same into the public highway there, and the wrongs then
and there did and committed; to the great terror of the
people of the said Commonwealth, to the great damage of
the said William Sampson and against the peace and
dignity of the Commonwealth aforesaid.
